Puyallup Tribal Community/Youth Center in Fife, WA, recently underwent a transformation, from a dilapidated yellow structure with ductwork and wiring across its exterior to a clean, beautifully crafted cedar-clad facility that welcomes members of the Puyallup Tribe to a variety of activities. The center complex includes a new gymnasium, canoe house, plaza and main building, which features a commercial kitchen, offices and an expansive gathering space with an eye-catching floor design, where community members meet for youth activities, meetings, weddings, funerals and other cultural events.
