

Stain table for everyday stain-causing substances

Stains will not appear if the substances listed in the table below are removed from the flooring straight away. They can only develop if the media are allowed to dry out. Treating stains can cause fading in the affected places and is usually the result of using higher concentrations of mop-care products after spillages. Depending upon the number and size of the stains, once they have been removed it may be advisable to clean the entire floor followed by a care treatment to assure a uniform overall appearance. This should be done using special cleaners by following the instructions in the technical leaflet. Change the exposure times according to the age and intensity of the stain. An unpleasant odour may be given off when cleaning large areas.

Type of stain	Cleaning agent	Removal
Blood	Diluted basic cleaning agent	Leave the basic cleaner solution for 10 - 15 minutes, then clean with a red pad or a soft brush.

Vomit, pus	Diluted basic cleaning agent	Leave the basic cleaner solution for 10 - 15 minutes, then clean with a red pad or a soft brush.
Coffee, tea	Dr. Beckmann Stain Devil Fruit & Drinks	Scatter the product and spray some water on it. Exposure time: approx. 1 - 2 hours.
	Dismozon pur	Exposure time: approx. 10 minutes. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
	Apesin AP 100	Exposure time: approx. 10 minutes. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
	Special cleaner TAM**	Exposure time: approx. 10 minutes. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
Fruit juices	Dismozon pur	Exposure time: approx. 10 minutes. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.

Contact adhesive	Nail polish remover, universal thinner	Rub with clean and damp cloth.
Rust	Rust remover	Apply stain removal agent and leave it for approx. 10 minutes. Then rub with a clean cloth. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
	Phosphoric acid-based sanitary cleaner	Apply stain removal agent and leave it for approx. 10 minutes. Then rub with a clean cloth. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.

Red wine	Dr. Beckmann Stain Devil Fruit & Drinks	Exposure time: approx. 30 - 60 minutes.
	Dismozon pur	Exposure time: approx. 10 minutes. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
Shoe marks, shoe polish, tar	Cleaning fluid with petrol base	Spray on, after a brief time to react remove with a clean cloth.
	Stain remover spray, e. g. Elatex	Spray on, after a brief time to react remove with a clean cloth.
Chewing gum	Multi-functional spray WD 40	Leave for approx. 10 minutes and remove the chewing gum stain with a wooden spatula.
Ink, ball point pen ink, marker, pencil	PepEx	Spray on, after a brief time to react remove with a clean cloth. See instruction manual.
Stamp-pad ink	Dismozon pur	Exposure time: approx. 10 minutes. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
	Apesin AP 100	Exposure time: approx. 10 minutes. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
Deposit of calcium carbonate	Phosphoric acid-based sanitary cleaner	Apply stain removal agent and leave it for approx. 10 minutes. Then rub with a clean cloth, a red pad or a soft brush. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
	Citric acid	Apply stain removal agent and leave it for approx. 10 minutes. Then rub with a clean cloth, a red pad or a soft brush. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
Residues from cigarettes	Dismozon pur	Exposure time: approx. 30 minutes. A brown shade might be left. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
	Apesin AP 100	Exposure time: approx. 30 minutes. A brown shade might be left. See instructions in the technical leaflet. May give off an unpleasant odour when cleaning large areas.
